

BRIDGWATER ONE 2019 - KIT LIST

Things you won't need to bring

- Bedding – this is all provided

Things to wear

- Suitable clothing for the houseparty. You will need clothes for indoor and outdoors including warm clothes for an outdoor evening activity. Don't forget underwear, socks etc, nightclothes.
- Some old clothes that can get dirty for some outdoor activities
- A waterproof coat
- Suitable trainers or shoes for outdoor activities
- Separate pumps, slippers etc for indoor wear
(outdoor shoes must not be worn inside Hill House)

Other essentials

- Toiletries
- Towel
- Bible (a modern translation), pens/pencils
- Any medicines you need. These must be labelled with your name.

Things for activities

- Please bring anything that you think could be helpful for worship workshop activities - eg musical instruments, camera (if you are planning to do photography as a specialist activity). You need to ensure that you have your own insurance cover for expensive instruments or equipment.

Spending Money

- There will be both a bookstall and a tuck shop on site, so it's sensible to bring some money to spend. The bookstall will have a range of helpful books appropriate for your age and some other Christian items such as bookmarks, badges and wristbands. There will also be Bibles on the bookstall.
- Please don't bring more money than you think you will spend. We suggest a maximum of £20.

Mobile Phones

- We recognise that members are likely to bring mobile phones. There will be just two rules that apply to both members and leaders:
 - You will be responsible for the security of your phone and other equipment.
 - You must use your phone and other equipment appropriately – have your phone switched OFF during meetings, workshops etc.

Please make sure everything you bring is marked in some way with your name. We will distribute any named lost property at the end of the week, but will not be able to send on any unnamed lost property after the houseparty.
