

BRIDGWATER OCTOBER - KIT LIST

Things you won't need to bring

- Bedding – this is all provided

Things to wear

- Suitable clothing for the houseparty. You will need clothes for indoors and outdoors including warm clothes for an outdoor evening activity. Don't forget underwear, socks, pyjamas etc.
- Some old clothes that can get dirty for some outdoor activities
- A waterproof coat
- Suitable trainers or shoes for outdoor activities
- Separate shoes, slippers etc for indoor wear (outdoor shoes must not be worn inside Hill House)

Special clothes (Bridgwater Two only)

- On the last night we will have the Bridgwater Ball. This is a three-course dinner held after the evening meeting. You may want to bring something to wear for the banquet – for example something you might wear to a party or wedding.

Other essentials

- Bible (a modern translation), pens/pencils
- Toiletries and a towel
- Any medicines you need - these must be labelled with your name.

Things for activities Please bring anything you think could be helpful for worship workshop activities – eg musical instruments, camera (if you are planning to do photography as a specialist activity). You need to ensure that you have your own insurance cover for expensive instruments or equipment.

Spending Money

- There will be a tuck shop on site which will be open briefly on most days. There is also a site gift shop selling books, cards and various small Christian items. It is sensible to bring some money to spend; we suggest a maximum of £10.

Mobile Phones

- We recognise that members are likely to bring mobile phones. There will be just two rules:
 - You will be responsible for the security of your phone.
- You must use your phone appropriately – have your phone switched OFF during meetings and activities, and it should not be used in dorms or bathrooms.

Please make sure everything you bring is marked in some way with your name. We will distribute any named lost property at the end of the week, but will not be able to send on any unnamed lost property after the houseparty.
